TEAM CONTRACT



Monthly payments are due by the first day of the *previous* month. Multiple monthly payments or one annual payment are also gladly accepted. Late fees will be assessed for those fees not paid by the due date, with the exception of September which is due in August. Monthly payments must be maintained in order for a team member to participate in meets. No refunds will be given.

I understand that my child must make the minimum weekly practice time for their level in order to maintain their team eligibility. I realize it is my responsibility to get my child to practice on time and to see that they stay until practice is over.

I am aware that we are obligated as a team family to work at and donate concession goods to all home meets. Gymnasts 14 & older may obtain the gym's permission to fulfill a family work obligation. Volunteer forms must be completed by all volunteers.

Youth on our team benefit from scholarships as do youth who attend our programs and use the facility. This year we'll host the Applebee's flapjack breakfast in January. Gymnasts are obligated to participate in at least 2 away meets prior to the YMCA League Championships (in March), and the YMCA State Championships (April). Team practices are canceled Fridays & Saturdays when competition has been offered that weekend unless otherwise stated.

Championships beyond the above mentioned are: USAG States, YMCA Regional, YMCA Nationals. Participation in these competitions is encouraged, but not required.

Uniform, meet fees, YMCA membership, USAG membership (for those who are eligible), team parties, special events and travel costs are the obligation of the team member's family. USAG membership is required for all team members' levels 4 through 10. Prep team may opt to purchase a USAG membership and attend any USAG meets which offer competition for your level.

All parent meetings will be held and your participation is important. We value your input. Our first "All Parent" meeting is scheduled for Friday, September 24, 7pm. Our first "New Parent" informational meeting will be Friday, September 10, 7pm.

Only those ages 12& older may retrieve mail from mail folders. Team parents should check the hall calendar, bulletin board and their mail folder weekly for updates and changes.

Meet fees MUST be paid by the due date. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! Meet fees are payable on line. We recommend not waiting until the last minute to pay meet fees.

I understand that I am not the coach and will not encourage my child to complain to me, but to go to the coach and learn to communicate their feelings with the coaches. Gymnastics is a very complex sport as is its scoring. I will leave the coaching to the coaches.
