



## **Glens Falls Capital Campaign Project Member FAQ -- 2 week branch closure**

### **What is the Glens Falls Capital Campaign Project?**

The Glens Falls Capital Campaign Project is a multi-million-dollar investment in the YMCA that will modernize and expand the facility. The goal of the project is to ensure the Y remains a healthy, vibrant, and welcoming space that meets the evolving needs of our growing community for years to come.

### **When does construction start?**

Construction will begin April 27, 2026.

### **How long will the project take to complete?**

Due to the scope of the project it is hard to provide an exact timeline but we expect the project to take at least 2 years to be completed.

### **Will the Glens Falls branch be closed during the construction?**

Yes, but only for the first two weeks of the project, beginning April 27th. This will allow us to safely and efficiently complete this initial phase. We expect to reopen on May 11, 2026 at which time the building will remain open during the remainder of the project.

### **Why does the branch need to close for the first 2 weeks?**

The temporary closure will allow the work to proceed safely, efficiently, and with minimal disruption to members and staff in the long run. This initial phase is a critical step in setting the project up for success and will lay the groundwork for a smoother, more effective construction process overall, helping to avoid longer or more frequent interruptions later.



## **How does this affect Spring 2 programs at Glens Falls?**

- Because of the temporary closure, the Spring 2 Program Session at the Glens Falls Y will start two weeks later than usual and will run from May 11 through June 28.
- Programs at all other branches will follow the regular Spring 2 schedule.
- Program registration for all locations, including the Glens Falls Y opens:
  - April 11 for SRYMCA members
  - April 18 for non members.

## **Will membership fees change during the closure?**

No. Members encouraged to use our other 6 locations that they have access to: Battenkill, Chestertown, Corinth, Malta, Saratoga Springs and Wilton.

## **How will my FLR membership be affected by the capital campaign project?**

The first phase of the project includes a full renovation of our locker rooms. To accomplish this the current 4 locker room model will be moved to 2 locker rooms and therefore the FLR model will be going away.

## **Please keep in mind:**

- The closure is temporary.
- Members have access to 6 other YMCA locations.
- The work is necessary to support long-term improvements.
- The project reflects a major investment in the community.
- We will be providing regular updates.
